

This website is operated by Schoeller Bleckmann Edelstahlrohr GmbH, Rohrstraße 1, A-2630 Ternitz („SBER“, “we”) and this notice is to inform you how personal data is processed by visiting this website.

1. Which categories of data we process

When visiting our website, the following information will automatically be collected:

- the called up site on our website (URL)
- the date and the time of the opening of a site on our website
- your IP address
- name and version of your web browser
- the website (URL) which you have visited before the opening our website
- certain cookies (see point 2) and
- the information you make available by filling in our contact form (“Get a Quote”)

There is no obligation to reveal your data in the contact form. But if you will not do it, it is not possible to use all the functions of this website.

2. Cookies

On this website, so-called “cookies” are used. A cookie is a small file, which can be kept on your computer by visiting a website. Basically, cookies are used to provide users with additional functions on a website. For instance, they can be used to simplify the navigation on a website, to give you the option of using the website where you have left it and/or to save your preferences and settings if you visit the website again. Cookies cannot access, read or change other files on your computer.

Most of the cookies on this website are so-called session-cookies. They will automatically be deleted, when you leave our website. On the contrary, persistent cookies stay on your computer until you delete them in your web browser manually. We use such persistent cookies to recognise you when you visit our website the next time.

If you want to control cookies on your computer, you can adapt the browser settings, so that you will get a message if a website wants to store cookies. You also can block or delete cookies that have been stored on your computer. If you want to have more information on how to take these steps, please use the “help”– function in your browser. Please note that blocking or deleting cookies can affect your online time and experience and could hinder you from using this website completely.

3. Purposes for which we process your data

We will process your personal data set out in Point 1 above for the following purposes:

- to make the website available for you and to improve and develop the website
- to create usage statistics
- to recognise, prevent and examine attacks on our website
- to answer your requests (“Get a quote”)

4. Legal basis of the processing

We process your personal data on the basis of our prevailing legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR) which is to achieve the purposes set out under Point 3 above.

5. Transfer of your personal data

Personal data, which is kept by visiting our website, will only be processed within SBER and will not be transferred to external recipients.

6. Retention periods

Personal data will be kept for three months. A longer storage only takes place (as far as this is necessary) to examine identified attacks on our website. The data collected in the context of a request, will be retained as long as there are statutory retention obligations.

General rights in connection with your personal data

Under applicable law, you have, among others, the right (under the conditions set out in applicable law):

- (i) to check whether and what kind of your personal data we hold and to request copies of such data,
- (ii) to request correction, supplementation or deletion of your personal data that is inaccurate or processed in non-compliance with applicable requirements, and
- (iii) to request the restriction of processing your personal data,
- (iv) in certain circumstances, to object for legitimate reasons, to the processing of your personal data or to revoke consent previously granted for the processing,
- (v) to request data portability,
- (vi) to know the identities of third parties to which your personal data are transferred, and
- (vii) to lodge a complaint with the competent authority.
