

With the following information, Schoeller Bleckmann Edelstahlrohr GmbH ("SBER GmbH", "we") would like to give you an overview of the processing of personal data in connection with surveillance cameras on the premises of SBER GmbH.

1. Categories of personal data

- Persons who are in the video-monitored area: image data (appearance, behavior), location of the image recording (premises, location of the camera), time of the image recording (date, time, start / end of the image recording)
- License plate number (to verify the entry authorization)
- In certain cases, an identification of persons may be necessary. Data may also be processed as follows: Identity of the persons concerned and the role of the parties (e.g. perpetrator, victim, witness), as far as it is apparent to the evaluator of the record.

2. Purposes of data processing

We process the personal data mentioned under point 1 for the following purposes:

- property protection
- compliance with safety or regulatory requirements
- checking the entry authorization

3. Legal basis of the processing

We process personal data because this is necessary to safeguard our legitimate interest (Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR in conjunction with § 12 (3) (1) DSG), which consists of the purposes of data processing (see point 2) to reach.

4. Evaluation and transfer of personal data

An evaluation of recordings of the cameras takes place only on occasion and if this is covered by one of the purposes of video surveillance (point 2).

Encrypted transfer of the data to external recipients is only possible in cases of authority (in particular court and prosecutor) and - as far as necessary - to legal representatives.

5. Retention periods

We will delete recorded personal data if it is no longer needed for the purpose for which it was collected and if there is no other legally required retention requirement. If there is no specific reason for a longer storage of the data, image recordings are stored for 72 hours (§13 Abs.3 DSG). If the end of this 72-hour period falls on a Saturday, Sunday, public holiday, Good Friday or 24 December, the next day, which is not one of the aforementioned days, is the last day of that period.

General rights in connection with your personal data

Under applicable law, you have, among others, the rights (under the conditions set out in applicable law):

- (i) to check whether and what kind of personal data we hold about you and to request copies of such data,
- (ii) to request correction, supplementation or deletion of your personal data that is inaccurate or processed in non-compliance with applicable requirements, and
- (iii) to request the restriction of processing of your personal data,
- (iv) in certain circumstances, to object for legitimate reasons to the processing of your personal data or to revoke consent previously granted for the processing,
- (v) to request data portability,
- (vi) to know the identities of third parties to which your personal data are transferred, and
- (vii) to lodge a complaint with the competent authority.
