The Tubacex Group defines all the Quality and HSE Guidelines applicable to all business sectors within the Tubacex Concern, based on the principle of our vision and commitment to the health of the employees, the quality of our products and our highest consideration for environmental protection. These guidelines also include the strategically-considered internal and external topics and the interested parties that are in context with SBER. The aims and basic principles concerning our mission in these areas are:

- Management of our business activities with the preventive emphasis on the health of the employees
 and human life above and beyond economic, commercial and productive aspects. All our business
 activities are executed in accordance with the current legal stipulations and in agreement with the
 guidelines of the Tubacex Group, as well as obligations requirements, are compared with the
 strategic aims and the results are assessed on a periodic basis.
- Securing customer satisfaction by complying with customer requirements by planning and checking our processes, by exceeding their expectations and by anticipating their needs so that these additional requirements can be integrated in our products.
